
Sing To The Lord A New Song

This is a Psalm that anticipates the coming of the Kingdom of God in glory. It is a Psalm that will finally know fulfillment when Jesus Christ comes to take his people home to heaven. We can sing in celebration, because each victory is an anticipation of the future victory, and each gathering of God's people is a foreshadowing of the great gathering in Heaven.

The reason the people are to sing is because they are to remember God's deliverance for them when we see the cross. The Lord's right hand and his holy arm have worked salvation for him and us. We know that God will act on behalf of his people.

God's faithfulness and righteousness is revealed through his salvation to Israel and to the ends of the earth. God is conducting a great international campaign of redemption.
