Beneath the hardest test.

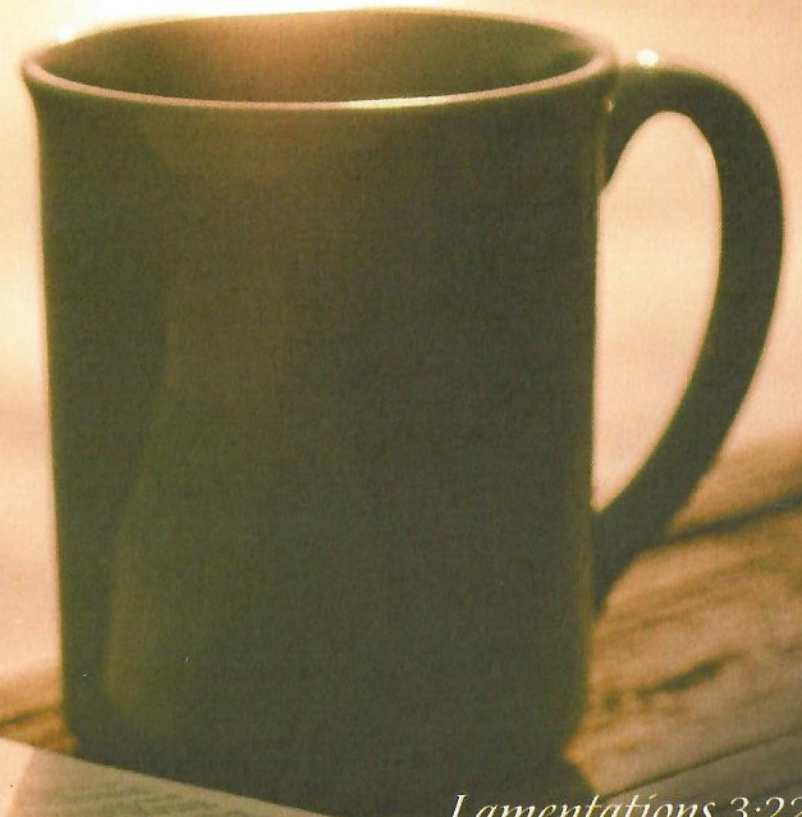
Lord, I would ask for a year of prayer,
