

## Promises of Psalm 103

God has promised us so many things in His Word. There are almost too many to count. We read these promises everyday when we read God's Word. Often we never give it a second thought.

But if we would take the time to really look at these rich verses, we will become amazed, strengthened, and feel secure in our life daily. We need to be reminded of God's compassion towards us through His promises.

1. Forgiveness for all our sins and does not punish, but loves us. Forgiveness means that God looks at us as though we never sinned. We are blameless before Him.
2. He heals us. Jesus has the ability and the willingness to heal us. We are not bothering God when we pray for healing; we are expressing our faith and trust in him.
3. He redeems and rescues us. God promises to rescue us not only for our welfare, but for His glory. No situation is too difficult for the Lord. The greater our need, the greater the depth of his love and compassion for us.
4. He crowns us with mercy and loving kindness. God's love pursues us everyday. We can be certain that God will continually shower us with his mercy and guard us in his love.
5. God knows we are weak. He softens his dealings to the weakness and frailty of our nature, and his compassion intercedes when the weight of sorrows would crush us.
