God Loves You

God absolutely loves you. It might be hard to get around it, but it is true. This is where the faith journey starts: understanding that God loves you. There is no force more powerful than the love our heavenly Father has for us, his children. His love can move mountains, stop the roaring seas, heal broken bones and wounded hearts, transform lives and set free those held captive by sin and shame. So great is his love for you that he sent his only Son to die that we might live through him.

God is a loving Father, who will always love you no matter what. Take time to receive the depth of his love for you today. Allow his love to heal you, transform you, free you, and lead you to the abundant life he has always longed to give. Read, meditate, and pray over these Bible verses about God's love as you walk in faith today.

God's love is gentle. Jesus said, 'Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you. Let me teach you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls' (Matthew 11:28-29).

God's love is faithful and merciful. "The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is his faithfulness; and his mercies begin afresh each morning" (Lamentations 3:22-23).

God Lovzs You (con't)

God's love is compassionate. "But you, O Lord, are a God of compassion and mercy, slow to get angry and filled with unfailing love and faithfulness" (Psalm 86:15).

God's love is unfathomable. "And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is. May you experience the love of Christ, though it is too great to understand fully. Then you will be made complete with all the fullness of life and power that comes from God" (Ephesians 3:18-19).

God's love is forgiving and full of grace. "Even when God's people refused to obey His Word, even after He performed miracles on their behalf, God was "a God of forgiveness, gracious and merciful, slow to become angry, and rich in unfailing love" (Nehemiah 9:17).

God's love is eternal. "For the mountains may move and the hills disappear but even then my faithful love for you will remain. My covenant of blessing will never be broken, says the Lord, who has mercy on you" (Isaiah 54:10).

We cannot be separated from God's love. "And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God's love. Neither death nor life, neither angels or demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow-not even the powers of hell can separate us from God's love. No power in the sky above or in the earth below-indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 8:38-39).

Absolutely nothing within our entire universe, seen or unseen, can separate us from God's kind, gentle, and merciful affection for us. His love is deeper than we can comprehend and eternally with us.
