Then Jesus told his disciples, "If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me."

We are invited to follow in his footsteps. Like him, we are to be ready to take up our cross, whatever it maybe, and carry it behind him. Jesus tells the disciples to take up their own cross not his.
