God is glorified in our willing obedience to the wisdom of His commandments. To be in God is to trust His Word, and to trust His Word is to obey and follow Him.

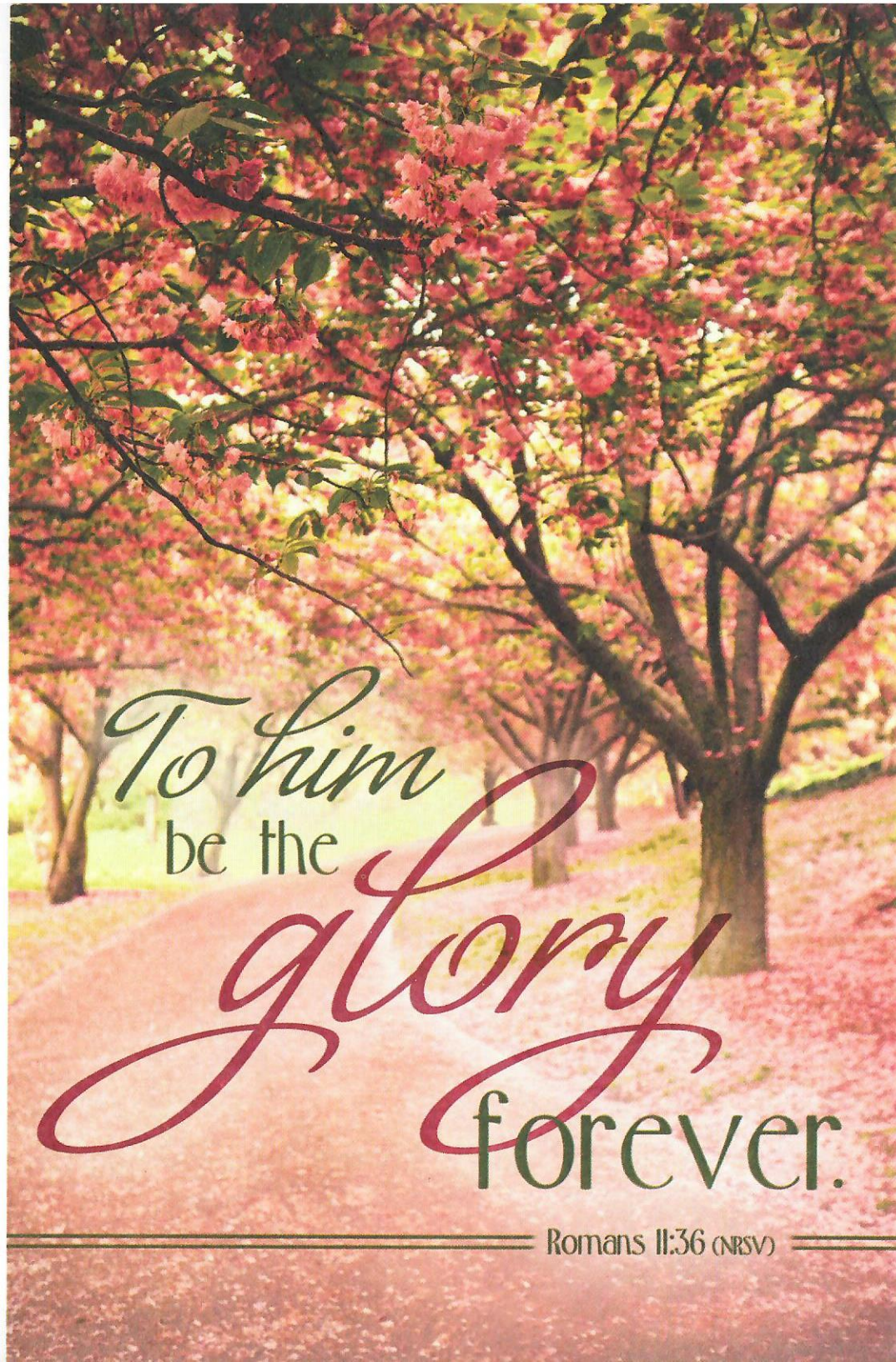
