John 14:6

In John 14, Jesus comforts His disciples as He prepares them for His imminent departure. He reassures them that He is going to His Father's house to prepare a place for them and promises that He will return to take them there. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life, and the only path to the Father.

<u>Jesus is the Way</u>—in a world full of confusion and uncertainty, Jesus presents Himself as the way to eternal life and fellowship with the Father. He is the bridge between humanity and God, offering salvation and reconciliation through His death on the cross. As Christians, we are called to follow Jesus as our guide, trusting that His way is the path to true, peace and contentment.

<u>Jesus is the Truth</u>—Jesus embodies truth. He offers an unchanging and reliable source of wisdom, guiding us in every aspect of our lives. By seeking Jesus and His teachings, we can gain a deep understanding of God's character and His will for us.

<u>Jesus is the Life</u>—Through Jesus, we receive the gift of eternal life. He gives eternal life to only those who believe in Him for salvation. God's covenant of grace covers everyone who have faith in Christ. Jesus is the giver of life and the only one who can take us to the place He prepared for us. He died so that we might not perish but have eternal life.

If you must know God, then you must know Christ. To know one is to know the other. To see one is to see the other. They are both the same being. Jesus is the way, the perfect truth, and the unending life.
