
Colossians 3:15-17

Gratitude Is Our Choice: Colossians 3:15 “Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace And be thankful.” We can’t always control our circumstances, but we can always control how we respond to them.

Gratitude Comes From God’s Word: Colossians 3:16 “Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.” As we study God’s word, we are reassured that He is in control, He loves us and He has a wonderful plan for us as we seek Him.
